1 Thought from Pastor Russ

Message: "Looking For A Way"

To say I'm "looking for a way" only begins the conversation. To be complete, we need to know more. Yes, there is the common thread of general "searching" that is part and parcel to the condition of being human.

To be "looking for a way" suggests movement, and that may be toward a physical location (like "Siri, route me to the closest gas station") or it may be more personal like "looking for a way to connect with a friend".

The truth is that most of our searching for "a way" is less concrete than a route map or calendar space.

In fact, most of our searching in life is related to one thing: Meaning. Looking earefully into our hearts and born out in the record of human history, is this single challenge: We are searching for a way to make sense out of the world in which we live.

We are searching for a way to make sense out of suffering, motives for behaviors both good and evil, and purpose for the practical things that make up life as we are living it. We want to understand this journey we call life.


Psalm 23: 2-4 says "He [the Lord] makes me lie down in green pastures, he leads me beside quiet waters, 3 he refreshes my soul. He guides me along the right paths for his name's sake. 4 Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me."

What strikes me about this is so simple it is easy to overlook. It describes the way through, not out of, the challenges of life. This matters more than we may realize.

My observation is that when we find the "green pastures" we begin looking for a way to stay in those places forever. And when we sense a "dark valley" on the horizon, we begin looking for a way around them. And when we find ourselves in the darkest valley, confronted by evil, we desperately look for a way out.

But the Psalm does not offer any of these. Instead, we are encouraged that with the Lord we can find the way through life—in its every aspect!





My future plan is to attend Kent State University at Ashtabula to pursue a career in Radiologic Technology in hopes of getting a certification in X-ray.






